EMBRACING RESPONSIBILITY

- A. Responsibility in Relationships
 - 1. Relationship with God. (Isaiah 55:6)
 - 2. Relationship with self. (Eph. 4:22,24)
 - 3. Relationship with others. (Rom. 12:18)

- B. Benefits of living with God.
 - 1. To know God and believe Him. (Isa. 64:4)
 - 2. To glorify God. (Isa. 43:6,7)
 - 3. To find satisfaction in God. (John 8:32)
 - 4. To experience God's peace. (2Th. 3:16)
 - 5. To enjoy God's presence. (Isa. 43:2)

- C. Obstacles that block access to the benefits of God.
 - 1. Unbelief, which hinders knowing God. (Isa. 57:14)
 - 2. Pride, which prevents us from glorifying God. (Isa. 57:15)
 - 3. Idolatry, which keeps us from being satisfied with God. (Isa. 44:10)
 - 4. Prayerlessness, which blocks our experience of God's peace. (Isa. 56:7)
 - 5. Legalism, which stops our enjoyment of God's presence. (Isa. 29:13)

- D. Seven Qualities of Responsible People. Responsible People:
 - 1. Are motivated.
 - 2. Are forward-moving.
 - 3. Make a difference.
 - 4. Are menders.
 - 5. Measure progress.
 - 6. Manage mistakes.
 - 7. Maximize opportunities.
